

# Stair Repairs – Laytown Racecourse

Larsen Contracts were engaged, by Laytown Racecourse Committee in Co. Meath, to repair and resurface the exposed concrete viewing area used by spectators at race meetings. Larsen have undertaken surfacing and repair works to many sports facilities including Croke Park, RDS Anglesea Road Stand and Down Royal Racecourse over the years. There were seven steps in total stretching a total of 120m along the shoreline facing the Irish Sea.



The Sikadur system was chosen for use on this repair scheme – works initially involved mechanical preparation of the entire staircase highlighting the damaged areas to be repaired first. Sikadur-42 was selected for repairs as it has a high compressive strength which is perfect for areas with high volumes of foot traffic. Larsen completed the works during a damp Irish Summer. The anti-slip system consisted of a fast curing primer coat of Sikafloor-10 Pronto, followed by a Sikafloor-15 Pronto elastomeric body coat. Quartz aggregate was added across the surface to achieve the desired level of non-slip finish. Sikafloor-18 Pronto was used as the tight sealing coat giving it a lovely grey finish which was complemented by the installation of vibrant yellow nosings which were applied as the final touch to complete the revamp.
